LiUNA Local 1611 offers two (2) Labourers Reconciliation through Indigenous Scholarship & Education (RISE) awards.

Deadline to apply for 2023/24 is Aug. 31, 2023

ELIGIBILITY

- 1. Members in good standing of LiUNA Local 1611 who identify as Indigenous (First Nations, Métis or Inuit)
- 2. Relatives of LiUNA Local 1611 members in good standing or relatives of deceased members (in good standing at time of passing) who identify as Indigenous (First Nations, Métis or Inuit). Definition of relative: a spouse, child, stepchild, grandchild or ward of the member.
- 3. Canadian resident or landed immigrant.
- 4. Registered in a full-time or part-time post-secondary program at an accredited educational institution or a trade or apprenticeship school/program.

Each applicant must provide:

* Completed application form.

* Proof of enrollment including RECEIPT of deposit AND course fees.

- It is understood that receipts for course payments to follow initial application if payment remitted after August 31, 2023.

* A letter explaining your education goals.

* A short statement on what Reconciliation with Indigenous Peoples means to you. You may do this in writing or as an audio or video recording. This should be between 200 and 400 words as a written statement OR 2 to 4 minutes as an audio/video recording.

Your application will be adjudicated by a panel of LiUNA Local 1611 members or staff who identify as Indigenous.
